Master of Science in Clinical Research Management

Per ACRP's 2020, "There is a strong demand for clinical research professionals, but data indicates workforce growth may not be keeping pace with growth in clinical trial demand".

The 36-credit SHP **Clinical Research Management** program is designed for students who would like to participate in clinical research at a Pharmaceutical, Biotech, Clinical Research Organization (CRO) company or an Academic Medical Center (AMC). The program covers the theory and application of research methods, basic statistics, regulatory and legal governances over clinical trials, and clinical operations.

Experiential training is threaded through the program. Students can select either the CRM, Academic CRM, or Drug Safety / Pharmacovigilance track. The majority of the courses are taught asynchronously and online. Depending on the track, other courses may be in-person. The Graduate Records Exam (GRE) is not required.

Admission Criteria for Early Acceptance Option into SHP CRM Program:

- 75 earned undergrad credits with min GPA of 3.0
- Earned "B" or better in the 2 SHP courses

Rutgers-Camden Health Science majors can begin taking 2 courses (6 credits) in Clinical Research Management (CRM) while finishing up their B.A. in Health Sciences.

- Courses will count towards both the ungraduated and graduate degree (if a B or better is earned)
- Pay undergraduate rates for SHP courses
- Via Early Acceptance Option, may be considered for MS CRM Program
- To be eligible, undergrad students in CCAS must have earned 60 undergraduate credits with a cumulative GPA of 3.0
